

RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE DAY COUNTY PDM PLAN

WHEREAS the Town of Roslyn has experienced severe damage from strong winds, flooding, hail, heavy snow, heavy rain, and tornadoes on many occasions in the past century, resulting in property loss, loss of life, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety;

WHEREAS a Hazard Mitigation Plan has been developed after more than one year of research and work by Day County Emergency Management, NECOG, and the Pre-Disaster Mitigation Committee;

WHEREAS the Plan recommends hazard mitigation actions that will protect the people and property affected by the natural hazards that face the County;

WHEREAS a public meeting was held to review the Plan as required by law;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESLOVED by the President of the Roslyn Town Board that:

1. The Hazard Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted as an official plan of Roslyn,
2. The respective City official identified in the strategy of the Plan is herby directed to implement the recommended action assigned to them. This official will report annually on the activities, accomplishments, and progress to Day County Emergency Manager, and
3. The Day County Emergency Manager will provide annual progress reports on the status of implementation of the plan to the County Commission. This report shall be submitted to the Commission by November 1st of each year.
